Create Aberdeenshire Learning Development Online (ALDO) account. Familiarise self with the Aberdeenshire mandatory training including the Child Protection in Education Professional Learning Framework as stated in the Pupil Support Worker (Complex Needs) Professional Learning Framework.	
Ask line manager and Head Teacher of Primary integrated Complex Needs Provision for  name of each school's Child Protection Co-ordinator and protocols to be followed in the event of a suspected Child
